Letter from the President:

Have you got your pier in yet? I know many of you have. It is not often we see piers and boats in the water in mid March, but this year spring appears to be arriving early. It was nice having a mild winter, but with that often comes the rapid start to vegetation growth. The DLPA along with Aquatic Weed Control will be monitoring the vegetation growth and doing spot control as necessary. Individuals can treat up to 625 square feet around your piers and swim areas, but the larger areas need to be handled by Aquatic Weed Control. Some homeowner groups in the past have secured Aquatic Weed Control to spray their shoreline areas, and that service will be available for them this year as well.

This year the DLPA has purchased new regulatory buoys to mark the shallow area along the north shoreline, and the swim area on the west side of the island. Thanks to Kyle Young and his team for prepping the new buoys and getting them in the water.

I'm sure each of you are looking forward to fun times on the lake again this year, keep in mind everyone's safety, and remember to be courteous to others using the lake.
