<u>Chicken Bar B Q</u> will again be held in the Syracuse New Market/Dollar General Parking lot on Saturday, June 17 th . Your Lane Director will have tickets for this event.	402 N Huntington St. (St. Rd. 13 south of the police station).
The <u>Flotilla</u> will be held on July 2^{nd} this year. Hope to see at least one boat from each lane.	You simply stop at one of these two fire stations and fill out a form. You can stop back in 2 or 3 days and pick up your sign. The cost is \$15.00.
<u>Buoys</u> Thanks to Kyle Young for the buoy placement around the lake again this year.	The signs should be mounted at a place where the numbers reflect headlights of vehicles driving past. That could be on a tree, a building, a post, a mailbox post, etc. They are numbers only (no letters) and can be ordered to be mounted either horizontally or vertically.
