### Notes from the President

Apparently we have had “perfect storm” weather this winter/spring that has resulted in earlier than normal growth of Eurasian Milfoil. It is unfortunate this is the year that the DLPA is undertaking a non-chemical treatment approach to these non-native extremely aggressive growing weeds.

As many of you know, in October 2011 the Directors approved a 4 year program to place native milfoil weevils in the lake this June to attempt to control the milfoil. The DNR LARE program also approved our grant request and are paying for 80% of the first 2 years \$40,000 cost. The DLPA and the DNR believe that the weevils may be a cost effective, non-chemical, species targeted method for long term control.

The weevils do **not** work immediately like chemicals and we may not see any changes in the milfoil this year. This will make swimming & boating difficult. The DNR and the weevil company will allow licensed chemical applicators to treat some of the areas away from the weevil placement areas. The weevils are to be placed in mid-June. More information will be available at the Annual Meeting.

When the weevils are placed the DLPA will erect a sign at the public access asking boaters to stay away from the buoyed weevil areas so they have a better chance to multiply. Please tell your boating family & friends to do the same. Boat propeller cutting will result in spreading the milfoil weed.

Some residents (especially west shore) have experienced bumps & itching on their skin while swimming. We think this is “swimmers itch”. This is likely a larvae of a parasitic organism whose normal life cycle is from snails to water to lake birds, i.e. ducks, geese & swans. The larvae are attracted to warm human bodies in the water. The larvae do not live long and cause an immune reaction, thus the bumps and itching. Drying off with towels may reduce the problem. At this time, we don't know if it's a short or long term problem.
